- 1. The righteous have a different relationship with sin. (v. 1–2)
  - \*Blessing 1: Their transgression is forgiven.
  - \*Blessing 2: Their sin is atoned for and silenced.
  - \*Blessing 3: Their iniquity is no longer counted to them.
- 2. The righteous still face sin and must respond to it. (v. 3–7)
  - \*The Spirit responds to our present sin in loving conviction.
  - \*We must respond in honest confession and repentance.
  - \*Rightly responding to sin clears and corrects our vision.
- 3. The righteous experience God's faithfulness. (v. 8–11)
  - \*The LORD is committed to teach us and stay with us.
  - \*Our lives should reflect God's faithfulness.
  - \*The wicked have no hope, but the righteous are never without hope.
