- *Implies a fall: People have great worth to God as image bearers
- *Implies a need: People need to be saved/reconciled/redeemed/restored to God
- *Implies inability: People on their own cannot save themselves.
- *Implies a provision: God, through the Gospel, offers salvation/rescue to sinners.
- *Implies a responsibility: The church is called to pray/love/serve/share the gospel.

 - *He is the King of all angels. (20–21)
