Colossians 3:1-17 - "Between the Already and Not Yet"

1. The Already (3:1–3)

- Raised with Christ (v. 1)
- Died with Christ (v. 3, Romans 6)
- Life hidden with Christ (v. 3)
- Christ is seated at the right hand of God. (v. 1)
 - This is what makes these others possible.
 - A finished work

2. The Not Yet (3:4)

- Christ will appear (v. 4)
- We will appear with him in glory. (v. 4)
- 1 John 3:1-3

3. The In-Between (3:5-17)

*The journey between the already and not yet is through a deeply fallen world that does not operate the way that God intended.

*It's me still struggling with the remaining presence of sin.

- Seek the things that are above (v. 1)
- Set your mind on things above, not on things that are on earth. (v. 2)

***But how do I do that? 3:5-17 fleshes this out both negatively and positively.

- 1. 3:5-9 is the "put them to death" imperative.
- 2. 3:12-14 is the "put on" imperative.
- 3. 3:15-17 is how to put it on.

1. Recognize that sin still remains in you.

- Put to death therefore what is earthly "in" you.
 - I thought I had died to these things.
 - Things are still at work in our members.
 - Here is the problem: we are often blind to our own tendencies.
 - v. 11 All of us struggle with this.
 - v. 10 is the how.

2. Let the Word of God transform the way you think about sin.

- The new self is being renewed in knowledge to its Creator.
- Commit to God's Word
- Romans 12:12 God transforms the way we think.
 - When the way we think about these things listed changes, we will be more prone to put them to death.
- <u>But we are often blind to our own tendencies</u>. We can see them in everyone else. This is why we need others to help us see them. Even though we have access to these things, we must make a decision to "put them on."

3. Remember whose you are.

- First, notice what Paul calls the church
 - "God's chosen ones"
 - "holy"
 - "beloved"
- You are no longer your own...
 - This is our identity. It fuels our activity
- Notice the stark contrast between the previous list and this one
 - kindness, compassionate hearts, humility, meekness, and patience
 - bearing with one another
 - forgiving one another
- This is much harder, isn't it?
 - put on love

4. Commit to the Word of God and the People of God

- Peace of Christ ruling your heart
- Be thankful
- Let the word of Christ dwell in you.
- Teaching and admonishing one another
 - Not talking about the preacher.
 - Talking about the beloved teaching and admonishing one another
 - Helping one another see our blind spots.
- Do all in the name of Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father.
- Do everything for His glory.

Application:

We exist for God's glory by committing ourselves to God's Truth, God's People, and God's Mission.

*God's Truth - transforms our thinking and our hearts

*God's People - people in place, people in places

- Scripture clearly teaches that my walk with God is a community project.
- Helps us see our blind spots
- We need hands on our lives.
- As long as sin is still present, there will be pockets of blindness.
- We have a delusion that we know ourselves better than anyone, but often times we can't accurately view ourselves.
- We need people that help us see ourselves with biblical accuracy.
- Being a people in place is beautiful and great, but we need to be people in places because that is where we are most seen, heard, and admonished.
 - It's personal.
