

## **Psalm 99**

### **“Exalt the Holy King”**

#### **1. Exalt the Holy King, We Must**

- The Lord reigns (1)
- Let the people tremble (1)
  - Those who know Him, tremble with the reality
  - Those who don't know Him, tremble with the reality
    - Saints quiver in devoted devotion
    - Sinners quiver in terror
- “Enthroned” upon the cherubim (2)
  - Ezekiel 1 and 10
  - Revelation 4\*
  - Fire, swift, protector, eyes, wings, beast/man
- He is transcendent (2)
- Not a local deity
- He is holy (3,5, 9)
  - More than anything else
  - Holy is the only title repeated 3 times for emphasis
  - Isaiah 6:1-4
  - “Holiness is the harmony of all the virtues. The Lord has not one glorious attribute alone, or in excess but all gloried are in him as whole; this is the crown of his honor and the honor of His crown. His power is not his choicest jewel, nor his sovereignty, but his holiness” — Spurgeon

#### **2. Exalt the Holy King, We May**

- He sits on a throne of mercy and grace
  - Exodus 25:17-22
  - Exodus 26:34
  - Leviticus 16
  - Romans 3:21-26
  - Hebrews 10:19-25
- His might loves justice, established equity, and executed justice
  - “He combines absolute might, with absolute right”
  - He doesn't use his power in a wrong way
- He is personal
- He is forgiving
