

## **Psalm 105:24-45**

### **POT— Covenant, Part 3**

**God redeems His people, dwells among them, and brings them in His kingdom to live for His glory.**

#### **1. He redeems and delivers (24-38)**

- God rescues His people from bondage through His sovereign power
- God multiplies His people (24-25)
  - Opposition cannot prevent God's purposes (Exodus 1)
  - His kingdom grows even in hostile environments
- God raises up His servants (26)
  - God sends Moses and Aaron (Exodus 2-7)
  - Redemption is His initiative
  - God provides a mediator for His people
  - God provides a priest for His people
- God displays His power (27-36)
  - Plagues reveal God's supremacy (Exodus 7-12)
  - Passover is initiated (Exodus 12)
  - Defining picture of salvation
- God accomplishes redemption (37-38)
  - Israel leaves Egypt completely free from bondage (Exodus 12:33-42)

Application:

- God still delivers sinners from bondage
- Sinners are saved by the power of God.. which is the gospel

#### **2. He resides and provides (39-41)**

- God not only delivers His people but dwells with them and sustains them
- His presence leads (39) (Exodus 13:17)
  - The cloud anticipates God's dwelling among His people in the tabernacle (Exodus 26)
- His provision sustains (40-41)
  - Quail for hunger (Exodus 16)
  - Bread from heaven (Exodus 16)
  - Water from a rock (Exodus 17)
  - Every need is supplied by His faithfulness
  - Christ is the bread of life and the living water and the rock from whom life flows
- God daily took care of their needs
- His faithfulness endures
- For every trial there was grace to meet it
- He is the same God today... He resides and provides

### **3. He rules and reigns (42-45)**

- God fulfills His promises because He reigns over history and nations
- His covenant governs history
  - He remembers His promise and everything works towards it
  - God's kingdom advances because He is faithful to His Word
- His joy marks His kingdom (43)
  - God brings people out with joy.
  - Redemption leads to worship (Exodus 15)
  - God's people should rejoice because their King reigns
- His sovereignty grants the inheritance (44)
  - He gives lands He promised (Conquest in Canaan through Joshua 24)
  - Israel receives what God provided
  - The inheritance is an act of grace not achievement
- His glory demand obedience (45)
  - They get the land so they can be His people a nation who reflects His glory
  - He had given Moses the law that created a nation, now they have the land in order for this nation/kingdom to expand and grow
